

1-3 Grade Discussion Questions

Ice Breaker Question.

Which do you like better: being loud or being quiet?

Choose a few review questions.

- 1. *When is it hard for people to listen to your words?*** *When my words are rude; when I think I'm better than other people; when I argue angrily; when I lie; etc.*
- 2. *When is it easy for people to listen to your words?*** *When I'm kind, honest, respectful, complimentary, and encouraging; when I listen and pray for them; etc.*
- 3. *What do you think people learn from you when you're loving toward them?*** *Answers will vary. Ideas: What God's love is like; they're important; God loves them; etc.*
- 4. *When is it hard for you to be loving toward someone?*** *Answers will vary.*

Choose an action step question.

1. **Who are the people you need to share God's Good News with?** *Answers will vary.*
2. **What are some creative ways we can share God's Good News with them?** *Answers will vary. Ideas: text them, write a letter, talk to them on the phone, be kind to them, invite them to church online, pray for them, etc. (Help your kids come up with creative ways to share God's Good News, despite our current limitations)*

Pray together.

1. **Ask** kids to share things they'd like to pray about.
2. **Write down** their prayer requests.
3. **Pray** together over the prayer requests.

Not sure what to pray? Pray this: God, Thank You for giving us Your Good News. When we share it, please help people want to follow You. In Jesus' name, amen.
