

4-6 Grade Activity Guide

High Card

This activity shows us how the thing that has the highest value in our life is the thing that beats everything else. That's what we worship.

Activity Objective

Be the team with the most cards won in a card-flipping face-off.

You'll Need

- A Deck of cards

1. **Before the activity begins: A parent will need to shuffle the deck of cards.**
2. Split the deck of cards in half and put a pile in front of each person.
3. If you have more than two people playing, divide into two teams and take turns.
4. Say, "We're going to do an activity called high card. The first person on each team will flip over the card and put it on the table face up. Whoever has the highest card wins and takes both cards. Two will be the lowest card, and after 10 the order of cards goes Jack, Queen, King, Ace. So Aces are the highest."
5. The first person from each team flips the top card.
6. Whoever has the high card wins, takes the other team's card, and puts them in a pile next to their team's deck of cards.
7. Continue playing, with the next two people in line facing off in the card battle each round. (Or if only two people are playing, just continue flipping cards as instructed above).
8. Play as time allows.
9. Teams count their cards.
10. The team with the most cards, wins!
