Ice Breaker Question.

Which foods taste good with salt on them?

Choose a few review questions.

1. **When do you think you should set a good example?** *Answers will vary.*
2. **Who do you think is watching the example you set?** *Answers will vary.*
3. **Why do you think we need God's help to set a good example for others?** *Answers will vary.*
4. **Jesus told us to be salt and light. What do you think it means to be salt?** *Setting an example that makes living God's way "taste good" to others*
5. **What do you think it means to be light?** *Setting an example that shows others God's way and what He's like*
6. **What examples aren't salt or light?** *Answers will vary.*

Choose an action step question.

1. **Who are the people you need to share God's Good News with?** *Answers will vary.*
2. **What are some creative ways we can share God's Good News with them?** *Answers will vary. Ideas: text them, write a letter, talk to them on the phone, be kind to them, invite them to church online, pray for them, etc. (Help your kids come up with creative ways to share God's Good News, despite our current limitations)*

Pray together.

1. **Ask** kids to share things they'd like to pray about.
2. **Write down** their prayer requests.
3. **Pray** together over the prayer requests.
