

# 1-3 Grade Discussion Questions

## Ice Breaker Question.

***What does ashamed mean? Afraid or embarrassed***

## Choose a few review questions.

1. **What is a testimony?** *The true story of how Jesus helped you and changed you*
2. **What might make someone feel ashamed of their testimony?** *They don't want others to know they used to make a lot of bad choices; they're afraid won't listen to or believe them; they're shy; etc.*
3. **What reasons do we have to not be ashamed of our testimonies?** *They show God's power in our lives and how God can change us; people might choose to follow Jesus when they hear our testimonies; etc.*
4. **How can talking about the person you used to be help someone believe in Jesus?** *It shows Jesus is real, He helped you, and He can help others, too.*

## Choose an action step question.

1. **Who are the people you need to share God's Good News with?** *Answers will vary.*
2. **What are some creative ways we can share God's Good News with them?** *Answers will vary. Ideas: text them, write a letter, talk to them on the phone, be kind to them, invite them to church online, pray for them, etc. (Help your kids come up with creative ways to share God's Good News, despite our current limitations)*

### Pray together.

1. **Ask** kids to share things they'd like to pray about.
2. **Write down** their prayer requests.
3. **Pray** together over the prayer requests.

**Not sure what to pray? Pray this:** God, Thank You for giving us Your Good News. When we share it, please help people want to follow You. In Jesus' name, amen.
