

1-3 Grade Discussion Questions

Ice Breaker Question.

When we do good deeds, who do we want people to be learning about and praising? God, Jesus

Choose a few review questions.

1. ***What's so important about living like Jesus when you're sharing God's Good News? People can trust you when you teach them how to follow Jesus.***
2. ***What might happen if you don't live like Jesus, but you try to teach others how to follow Jesus? They can get confused and lose trust in you.***
3. ***Name some times it might be hard for people to learn about God from your life. When you're not living like Jesus; having a bad attitude, making poor decisions, being disrespectful or disobedient, etc.***
4. ***When does your life shine a light on what Jesus is like? When I'm helpful, kind, put others first, etc. Who trusts***

Choose an action step question.

1. **Who are the people you need to share God's Good News with?** *Answers will vary.*
2. **What are some creative ways we can share God's Good News with them?** *Answers will vary. Ideas: text them, write a letter, talk to them on the phone, be kind to them, invite them to church online, pray for them, etc. (Help your kids come up with creative ways to share God's Good News, despite our current limitations)*

Pray together.

1. **Ask** kids to share things they'd like to pray about.
2. **Write down** their prayer requests.
3. **Pray** together over the prayer requests.

Not sure what to pray? Pray this: God, Thank You for giving us Your Good News. When we share it, please help people want to follow You. In Jesus' name, amen.
