

4-6 Grade Activity Guide

Distracting Math

This activity helps show that we can get so distracted by all the things in our lives that we can't focus on, or worship, God.

Activity Objective

Try to get as many math questions right as possible—even with distractions.

You'll Need

- No materials needed

Instructions

1. Choose one family member to be the math question asker and one to be the scorekeeper.
2. Divide into two teams.
3. Say: "I'm going to ask you some really simple math questions, but there's a catch. The others are going to yell out random numbers while you answer!"
4. Tell the those not answering to yell out numbers while people are answering.
5. Take turns between the teams. Ask each team a math question from the Math List below. The scorekeeper will keep track of the points.
6. Keep playing as long as desired, giving each team the same amount of questions.

Math List:

$2 + 2 = 4$	$1 + 7 = 8$	$10 + 4 = 14$
$8 + 2 = 10$	$6 + 3 = 9$	$10 + 10 = 20$
$4 + 5 = 9$	$7 + 7 = 14$	$5 + 8 = 13$
$3 + 3 = 6$	$8 + 5 = 13$	$9 + 2 = 11$
$5 + 3 = 8$	$2 + 3 = 5$	$4 + 4 = 8$
$9 + 1 = 10$	$14 + 2 = 16$	$6 + 6 = 12$
$4 + 7 = 11$	$6 + 7 = 13$	$6 + 9 = 15$
$12 + 8 = 20$	$6 + 5 = 11$	$8 + 8 = 16$
$9 + 9 = 18$	$9 + 7 = 16$	$7 + 2 = 9$
