

1-3 Grade Activity Guide

What you'll need

- Small strips of paper and tape (or sticky notes)
- Pens or Pencils
- Blank large sheet of paper or empty wall

To Do

Say: "Nehemiah did something good to make a difference: he built a wall to protect his people. We're going to build a wall, too. These pieces of paper (or sticky notes) are your bricks."

1. To start out, give each family member 5 pieces of paper (or sticky notes).
2. **Say:** "Think of some evil situations that bother you. Write or draw good things you can do to make a difference."
3. Everyone will draw or write good things on each brick.
4. When the bricks are completed, tape or stick to large peice of paper (or wall) to build a "wall".
5. If desired, play the telephone game with the Bible Verse and the Point.

After the activity ask:

1. **How old do you think you have to be to make a difference?** *Answers will vary.*
2. **Vintage Konnect Trivia: What did the Konnect crew d at the International Galactic Intelligence Symposium?** *They shared their testimonies.*
