

4-6 Grade Activity Guide

Partner Flags

This is a fun way to show how friends sacrificially protect one another.

Activity Objective

Be the team to have at least one flag left.

You'll Need

- Pieces of paper and tape (or sticky notes)

Instructions

1. Give each family member a piece of paper (or sticky note) to tape to themselves
2. Everyone is to stick it to themselves, creating a "flag" that hangs off of them. (It does not matter where they stick it, just has to be somewhere where it can be seen by the others).
3. Members should be paired into a group of two people. Each able to protect and guard each other's flags.
4. When you say "GO" each team will try to capture the "flags" of the opposing teams.
5. Teams are to remain close to one another and try to guard each other's flags.
6. Reminder that teams are one unit, so if a partners flag is stolen, they are not out unless both of their flags are stolen.
7. Play until only one team is left with at least one flag still attached.
